

SC High School Graduation Requirements

The student must earn a minimum of 24 units of credit in state approved courses.

The unit requirements are distributed as follows:

1. Students planning on entering a 4-Year college//University after graduation are expected to earn 3 credits in courses designated as a "Lab Science". Physical Science is a foundational science and is useful in preparation for the other offered science courses but is not designated as a "Lab Science" by SC colleges/universities
2. Students in a College Prep program must earn one unit in a foreign language (Note: Most 4-Year colleges/universities require at least two years of the same foreign language). Students in a Tech Prep Program must earn one unit in career and technology education course.
3. Beginning with the class of 2011 colleges require that students earn at least one Fine Arts credit.
4. Must also pass the exit examination (HSAP).
