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| <p>Choose a quotation - any passage from the text – that seems significant, memorable, or confusing.</p> <p>Copy the quotation exactly as it appears onto the left side of your table; place it in quotation marks and include the page number.</p> <p>Choose a minimum of 8 quotations from the novel.</p> | <p>Write your response on the right side of the table.</p> <p>Begin your response with a brief explanation of the content of the quote.</p> <p>Now, write your response to the quotation. You may include observations, revelations, questions, or reflections – any thoughts you have about the quotation’s significance. In addition to your personal thoughts, you may discuss the author’s use of language. How does he convey his ideas? Who is his intended audience and what is his purpose? What are the techniques he uses to accomplish his purpose? Is he successful? These questions are suggestions for your responses. You do not need to answer every one of these questions in your responses.</p> <p>The double entry journal must demonstrate that you have carefully read and understood the book. Do not simply summarize; you must analyze and evaluate.</p> <p>Each of your response entries should be approximately 100- 300 words.</p> |
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
