

2018 - 2019 AP LATIN SUMMER READING SCHEDULE

Aeneid Readings will be uploaded each Monday and copies will be in my box at school on the 18th of June for all sections if you prefer to pick them up rather than print them. The study questions will be in Google Documents in Google Classroom for you. If you need them printed let me know!

Caesar Readings: I have your books! Don't write in them - They are school copies! I'll put them in a box with your name on them and leave them in my box at school. Swing by when you have a chance and pick it up.

Vocabulary and Latin readings: These will be going up as fast as I complete them over the summer. Everything you get done during the summer will be one less assignment you need to complete in the 1st quarter. Each classroom assignment will state when the handouts will be ready to pick up if needed. You are also welcome to print at home if you want.

English Reading Schedule

(N.B. There are fun suggestions to help you set the atmosphere with each assignment. If you do them take a selfie and upload it the Google Classroom assignment for the week! It will be a lot of fun!)

Week of June 4th - 8th: Relax this week and recover from the year! Drink lots of water. Get plenty of sleep. Spend time outside and do something fun with your friends. Help your parents around the house. Watch some Netflix but not TOO much.

Week of June 11th - 15th: Read the Introduction I sent home with you. Answer the study questions. These will be available online in Google Classroom. If you don't already wear reading glasses, wear some fake ones. It will make you feel like a scholar.

Week of June 18th - 22nd: Read Book 1 and fill out the study questions. If you can, sit next to a window during a thunderstorm while reading. Trust me. It makes it better.

Week of June 25th -29th: Read Book II of the Aeneid and fill out the study questions. Dress in all black while you do so to mourn the fall of Troy.

Week of July 2nd - 6th: Read book IV and fill out the study questions. Do so in a comfy chair and a large serving of break-up ice-cream. Keep tissues nearby to mourn the passing of Dido.

Week of July 9th - 13th: Read book VI and fill out the study questions. Read in your room with most of the lights out and the curtains drawn for the right effect. If possible, play spooky halloween noises on your phone.

Week of July 16th - 20th: Read book VIII and fill out the study questions. If possible, obtain a Nerf sword and shield (or make cardboard ones lol) and keep them at your side while you read.

Week of August 6th - 10th: Read Book 5 of the Gallic Wars and answer the study questions. After completion, attempt to plant a flag in your sibling's room. Tell your sibling it's part of your summer assignment and see what happens.

Week of August 13th - 17th: Read Book 6 of the Gallic Wars and answer the study questions. Read while surrounded by your family images (I mean pictures) and any religious symbols you might have in your home.
